Below is a description of the EB ESA Annual Meeting Theme. Although we prefer that symposia address issues related to the theme, other symposium topics will also be accepted.

**Entomology in a changing environment**

Entomologists are faced with significant changes in many aspects of how we do our jobs: environmental, political, regulatory, and technological, to name a few. The theme of this year's annual meeting, "Entomology in a changing environment," recognizes the unprecedented changes taking place in our world, and how those changes impact our science. We are calling for symposium ideas that will hopefully incorporate this theme. Topics might include global warming and its impact on biodiversity and insect distribution; homeland security; the introduction and management of alien species; the impact of new pesticide discoveries and regulatory changes on pest management strategies; and new molecular tools for insect identification, monitoring, management, and/or phylogenetic and ecological studies.
